

COUNTY ORDINANCE


***AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT HUNTING AND FISHING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY
WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE LANDOWNER OR LESSEE.***

It is unlawful to take wildlife or attempt to take wildlife on the land of another, or to fish on the land of another, without having on one's person while hunting or fishing the written permission, signed and dated for the current hunting or fishing season, of the landowner or lessee, or the landowner's or lessee's designee. The written permission shall not be valid for more than one year and may be valid for a shorter period stated in the permission. The written permission shall be displayed upon request of any law enforcement officer of the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission, by the Sheriff and deputy sheriff's of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office, and by other law enforcement officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.

Violation of this act is a Class 2 misdemeanor and a \$250.00 fine and jail sentence not to exceed 2 years and an order by the judge to complete a hunter's safety course.

This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission, by the Sheriff and deputy sheriff's of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and by peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.


